## Updates from Pin,

### Two day medical mission trip:

First of all, I want to thank our sponsors and the Lord for His goodness. We ended up having a team come in to do a medical mission trip with our girls. The day before the mission trip, I felt we encountered spiritual warfare. For me personally, I had a bad headache and felt my head was spinning. I ended up praying in my bedroom until noon and the Lord healed me. I continued to pray for God's protection and in the evening I found out that one of our girls was in a car accident when a car cut in front of her as she was driving back from school. She was a little hurt and shocked but the person at fault paid for the injuries and the motorcycle repairs. She ended up being ok enough to join us for the mission trip the next day.

Three of our doctors on the medical team ended up getting sick and another person had a death in the family. However, despite the opposition, and there being so many different nationalities on the team; Australia, Singapore, Hong Kong, China, Germany, and Thailand, we were still able to walk in unity and experience his presence. Seventeen people gave their hearts to the Lord and one person who was deaf was healed. Another person who was an alcoholic claimed to be hungry all the time, but when he came his hunger pains left him.

Before we would start our day, we would worship and prayer together. At first our girls felt

overwhelmed and thought they wouldn't be able to do the work. But when it came time to serve, it came easy to them and they had fun. Our girls gained a lot from this experience as they observed with the team. They witnessed the team's heart on service to others and how they sacrificed financially when they bought tickets, booked hotel rooms and had to spend their money on the food. The team even donated towards other expenses before returning home.

### Valentine's party:

We decided to have a Valentine's Day party at Hannah House. We decorated, ordered flowers and food and had our girls prepare games and worship songs. I think that a couple of other girls we knew might feel lonely on Valentine's Day so we invited them to join us as well. The girls asked me why I didn't go and spend Valentine's Day

with others. I told them that they were my special people. After the event almost everyone posted a story and shared how they felt loved. Some said this was the first time to receive a rose on Valentines Day. We had some extra roses and so I decided to take a girl and go give them out. The people we gave them to seemed to really appreciate our gesture.

### **Chiang Mai Campus Crusade for Christ**

We went and joined Campus Crusade for Christ for their last chapel service. It was a great way to help our girls gain a new perspective of how another ministry serves. What they did was very similar to what we do. They worshipped in small groups and played a couple musical instruments. We were able to see people trying to serve for their first time. One boy ended up giving his testimony for the first time, another attempted her first prayers in a group setting. It was encouraging to see these people overcome their fear and step out. Our girls minister a lot but they still sometimes get nervous when they have to serve in front of adults.

What was also encouraging to our girls was to see these students who are busy with school and homework step up to help connect other people with the Campus Crusade staff. This made our girls feel they too wanted to serve God in a greater capacity. They realized that if you have a heart to serve then you will make time for it.

### **Waterfall trip**

Due to us having room at Hannah House, we five other girls who came to stay with us. So for the end of the school year we need up going on a trip to a waterfall which allowed us to bond on a deeper level and to enjoy some games and worship together. A couple nursing students who are staying with us temporarily because their dorms were undergoing construction said they usually didn't go anywhere. It was a blessing to spend time together as a group.
