## Updates from Pin:

### Street Outreach

Each month we do an outreach with our Hannah House girls. This month we decided to minister at the local market which was a first for us. Most of the people we engaged with responded favorably. Some people didn't want to talk with us but we spoke kindly to them and they agreed to talk and let us pray for them. While we were there, there was a boy who was selling corn who had seen us minister regularly with the kids at school. He would watch us as we spent time with the other kids but kept his distance because he was a part of a different school and didn't think we would welcome him. We talked to him about God and told him God could do anything. He asked if God could help his grandma. She had been sick for a long time and had an earache and headache for many years. She had even gone to a doctor who said she couldn't be cured. We prayed for her and nothing happened. Then I felt God say to share the Gospel with her. After sharing she received Jesus and then without further prayer, God healed her earache and headache!

### Beach trip:

This year we had 9 of our Hannah House girls graduating so we took them to the beach down south. For almost all our girls, this was their first time to see the sea, play at the beach and go snorkeling. When they went snorkeling they

were afraid of drowning but after attempting it they found it to be a lot of fun and no one wanted to return to Chiang Mai. This kind of trip was so special that one girl scooped up some sea water to bring back to her parents! We had such a great time eating, traveling, playing and worshipping the Lord. It was awesome to see the girls care for one another. During a time of worship, the girls cried because soon many of them would be moving out of Hannah House.

### Youth camp:

This last month our girls were able to participate as leaders at a youth camp that had about 2,000 participants. They were exhausted but they loved serving and felt God's blessings, presence, and love there. The kids took time to listen to the voice of God. One girl said God spoke to her heart and told her He wanted to use her to share Christ



among people who didn't know God. Another shared a word that confirmed that message. The girls felt very empowered through this experience.

For this camp, we took kids from a school we had been ministering to. These kids had a wonderful but strange experience there. They began crying and didn't know why. As they cried, they experienced joy in their hearts. One girl said she was so burdened by her family and other situations with her friends, but when God touched her, He delivered her from the pain and stresses of these relationships. She said she had never experienced the Spirit move so powerfully in a worship service. These kids expressed that they wanted to go to our church.

#### **Graduates:**

As I mentioned before, we have nine students who graduated. These students shared with me how thankful they were for you helping to give them a place to stay, food, and an opportunity to grow in their knowledge of God. They felt that your sponsorship had a very significant part in them being able to graduate and being able to experience the blessing of living at Hannah House. Most of the girls, when they first arrived in the city were afraid. They didn't have confidence to drive a motorcycle in the city nor feel confident to talk to strangers. However, after spending time here, they were able to adjust. Some initially didn't know how to pray well in Thai. Some were rebellious and some selfish but their lives changed and now they walk with God. Our teaching has brought them closer to God and now they are bold in worship, prayer, and have the confidence to speak with those that don't know about God.

#### **Jonathan:**

What a bitter sweet time it is at Hannah House. Every three or four years as a graduation present we take the girls down south to experience the beach. I don't think we have ever had so many girls graduate in a single year. Please keep the girls in your prayers as they are sent out from

Hannah House as lights for the kingdom of God. Please also keep Pin and Rang in your prayers as they will be looking for new girls to replace those who are leaving. Thank you all for your support of our work. God bless!
